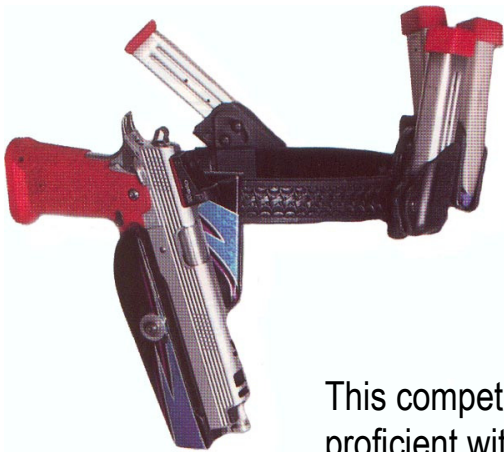


Introduction to Handgun Competition
