

2009 ILLINOIS STATE SERVICE PISTOL CHAMPIONSHIP
CMP SERVICE PISTOL “LEG” MATCH
NRA DISTINGUISHED REVOLVER MATCH
Sponsored by the ISRA Conventional Pistol Committee

Sunday, June 7, 2009

WHO MAY COMPETE: Open to any member of the National Rifle Association who also meet the eligibility requirements specified under CMP rules. You must be a **resident of Illinois** and a member of the **Illinois State Rifle Association** to be the **State Service Pistol Champion**. NRA and ISRA membership forms will be available at the range.

LOCATION OF RANGE: Approximately 10 miles west of Kankakee, Illinois on Warner Bridge Road, approximately 1 mile north of Illinois State Route 17.

REGISTRATION FEE: There will be a NRA registration fee and CMP registration fee.

ENTRY FEE: “Shoot the Works”	\$45.00
Service Pistol Championship	23.00
CMP “Leg” Match	15.00
NRA Distinguished Revolver Match	12.00

ENTRIES: Entries will be limited to 50 competitors. One relay. Shoot the works entries will be given preference.

TIME: Registration begins at 8:00 a.m. State Service Pistol Championship will begin at 9:00 a.m. CMP “leg” match will begin after service pistol championship; distinguished revolver match will begin after “leg” match. There will be a 20 minute break between matches.

RULES: Current NRA and CMP rules will govern this match. Competitor will score and change targets. Bring your stapler.

CHALLENGES: challenge fee is \$2.00. A NRA referee or jury system will be used. The plug-type scoring gauge will be restricted to range personnel only.

CLASSIFICATION: NRA classification system will be used for the championship. Unclassified competitors will fire in the master class.

CATEGORIES: Competitors will not be separated into categories.

FACILITIES: 50 firing points, controlled by loudspeakers. Line is poured concrete and covered. Targets are electrically operated. Potable water and restrooms are available at the range.

ARMS AND AMMUNITION:

Service Pistol Championship and CMP “Leg” Matches

Competitors may use a pistol that was issued by the U.S. Armed Forces or a commercial pistol of the same type and caliber: U.S. pistol caliber 45, M1911, M1911A1 or U.S. pistol 9MM,M9, having not less than four(4) pounds trigger pull as prescribed in CMP competition rules. Competitors may use any safe 45 caliber 230-grain FMJ round-nose bullet or 9MM, 115 to 125 grain FMJ, round-nose bullet.

Distinguished Revolver Match

The revolver must be a factory manufactured revolver with NO external modifications, capable of chambering and firing a 158-grain lead round nose or semi-wad cutter 38 special cartridge. Trigger must have single and double-action capability and be capable of lifting 2 ½ pounds when the revolver is cocked for single action firing. Barrel cannot

exceed 6 inches and adjustable front sights are prohibited. Stocks may be modified or changed but must be mirror images of each other. Only new, factory manufactured or commercially re-manufactured ammunition may be used.

Arms and ammunition will be weighed and inspected by the referee or chief range officer.

COURSE OF FIRE:

1. Service Pistol Championship

Match 1. 20 shots Slow Fire @ 50 yards, B6 target

Match 2. 30 shots NMC

(10 shots SF @ 50 yards, 10 shots TF @ 25 yards, 10 shots RF @ 25 yards).

Match 3. 20 shots Timed Fire @ 25 yards, B8 target

Match 4. 20 shots Rapid Fire @ 25 yards, B8 target

Match 5. Aggregate of matches 1,2,3 and 4.

2. CMP "Leg" Match and

3. NRA Distinguished Revolver Match

First Stage: 10 shots SF @ 50 yards, B6 target

Second Stage: 10 shots TF @ 25 yards, B8 target

Third Stage: 10 shots RF @ 25 yards, B8 target

AWARDS: Cash awards for the Service Pistol Championship. In addition, the winner of Match 5 will receive the perpetual Service Pistol Championship Trophy for the year. This trophy will be passed on to the next year and subsequent Service Pistol Champions.
