

**Illinois State Rifle Association
Springfield Armory Pistol Match 2023**

Dates: June 18, July 16, August 20, 2023

Location: ISRA Range, 1589N 7000W Rd; 1 ½ miles north of Rt 17 on Warner Bridge Rd.

Time: 8:30-9:00a.m. – Registration
9:15a.m. – Range Safety Briefing (required for all shooters)
9:30a.m. – Competition Begins

Equipment required: Springfield Armory pistol (any caliber), 2 magazines, 2 magazine pouches, holster, ink pen, ball cap, ear and eye protection required. If you do not have a Springfield pistol, you may shoot your first match that meets round qualifications. NOTE: You will draw from your holster. Junior shooters are welcome with a parent; the course may be modified if necessary for beginner shooters.

Limited to Springfield Armory XD, XDM, and 1911's, using special Springfield targets.

Course of fire is 50 rounds, total:

4 yards, 10 shots, 16 seconds (magazine change required)
7 yards, 15 shots, 19 seconds (magazine change required)
15 yards, 15 shots, 23 seconds (magazine change required)
25 yards, 10 shots, 21 seconds (magazine change required)

Concealed Carry Division compact models: 911, XDS, XDE, and Hellcat.

Course of fire is 30 rounds, total:

4 yards, 10 shots, 16 seconds (magazine change required)
7 yards, 10 shots, 16 seconds (magazine change required)
15 yards, 10 shots, 16 seconds (magazine change required)

Lewis class winners in A, B, and C class.

Final score will use your first match or your first re-fire (whichever is higher).

All shooters must assist range officers and act as scorers.

You will be entered in a drawing for a new Springfield Armory pistol, donated by Springfield Armory, for every match and every re-fire you enter in the months of June, July, and August. Only one pistol will be given away. Drawing will be held at ISRA Headquarters after the August match.

Cost: \$20 (1 gun); \$35 (2 guns); \$50 (3 guns); \$5 for re-fires.
