Must have 1 NRA Certified Instructor per discipline and 1 NRA Certified Range Officer per discipline. Both are available through the ISRA.

Scouts may borrow ISRA .22 rifles and shotguns at no charge. Group must furnish their own targets and factory ammunition. Only paper targets are approved for rifle; clays for shotgun. Leaders must have valid FOID cards to check out firearms. Your APPROVED firearms may also be used.

Eye and Ear protection is mandatory – available through ISRA at no charge.

Camping is permitted in designated areas only. Please remain in designated areas at all times - anyone not in designated area will be immediately removed from the Range.

Assigned Range(s) are for scouts only (parents may participate with scouts). All other ranges are off limits. 1 Parent per 5 Scouts. No scouts should be moving between ranges or clubhouse without an adult leading the group.
